TYPE OF MEETING: ANNUAL MEETING, BUDGET VOTE AND ELECTION

The Annual Meeting, Budget Vote and Election of Board Members was held on Tuesday, May 20, 2014 from 1:00 PM to 8:00 PM in the Central Office Lobby.

The polls were declared open at 1:00 PM.

District Voters Voted:

1. On the following Budget Resolution:
Resolved that the Board of Education of the Moriah Central School District, Essex County be and hereby is, authorized
To Expend the Sum of \$15,697,757.
2. Proposition #1
Shall the Board of Education be Authorized to purchase and finance two school buses and one passenger van at a cost not to exceed **\$206,100.00**, including required furnishings, fixtures and equipment and all other necessary costs incidental thereto and to expend not to exceed **\$206,100.00**, which is estimated to be the total maximum cost thereof, and levy a tax which is hereby voted in the amount of **\$206,100.00**, which shall be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education and in anticipation of the collection of such tax, bonds and notes of the District are hereby authorized to be issued at one time, or from time to time, in the principal amount not to exceed **\$206,100.00**, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said obligations when due.

The Moriah Central School District as a local agency pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), ECL Section 8-0101, et seq., and implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617, having reviewed the impact of the bus acquisition described herein upon the environment, determined that such project constitutes a "Type II Action" under the Regulations and, as such, is not subject to review under SEQRA.

3. For four candidates to fill four seats on the Board of Education, three positions each with a three-year term and one-position with a two year term:
 - a. Timothy Breeyear
 - b. Daniel Sadowski
 - c. Sharon Callahan
 - d. No designating petition was filed for this position. Write-in votes resulted in:
