The Annual Meeting, Budget Vote and Election of Board Members was held on Tuesday, May 16, 2017 from 1:00 PM to 8:00 PM in the Central Office Lobby.

The polls were declared open at 1:00 PM.

District Voters Voted:

1. **Proposition #1**

Resolved that the Board of Education of the Moriah Central School District, Essex County be and hereby is, authorized

To Expend the Sum of \$16,756,338.

2. **Proposition #2**

Shall the Board of Education of Moriah Central School purchase two school buses at a cost not to exceed \$186,327.32 including required furnishings and costs incidental thereto and levy a tax in the amount of \$186,327.32, to be collected in annual installments, issue bonds and notes in an amount not to exceed \$186,327.32, and levy a tax to pay the interest on said obligations when due.

The Moriah Central School District as a local agency pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), ECL Section 8-0101, et seq., and implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617, having reviewed the impact of the bus acquisition described herein upon the environment, determined that such project constitutes a "Type II Action" under the Regulations and, as such, is not subject to review under SEQRA.

3. **Proposition #3**

Shall the Board of Education of Moriah Central School reduce the number of Board of Education members from nine to seven members with two members elected for a three year term and one member elected for a two year term in May 2018, and three members elected for a three year term in May 2019.

- 4. For one candidate to fill one seat on the Board of Education, one position with a three-year term:
 - a. Daniel Sadowski
