TYPE OF MEETING: ANNUAL MEETING, BUDGET VOTE AND ELECTION

The Annual Meeting, Budget Vote and Election of Board Members was held on Tuesday, May 15, 2018 from 1:00 PM to 8:00 PM in the Central Office Lobby.

The polls were declared open at 1:00 PM.

District Voters Voted:

1. **Proposition #1**
Resolved that the Board of Education of the Moriah Central School District, Essex County be and hereby is, authorized
To Expend the Sum of \$17,437,946.

2. **Proposition #2**
Shall the Board of Education of Moriah Central School purchase one school transportation vehicle at a cost not to exceed **\$30,000** including required furnishings and costs incidental thereto and levy a tax in the amount of **\$30,000**, to be collected in annual installments, issue bonds and notes in an amount not to exceed **\$30,000**, and levy a tax to pay the interest on said obligations when due.

The Moriah Central School District as a local agency pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), ECL Section 8-0101, et seq., and implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617, having reviewed the impact of the student transportation vehicle acquisition described herein upon the environment, determined that such project constitutes a "Type II Action" under the Regulations and, as such, is not subject to review under SEQRA.

3. For three candidates to fill three seats on the Board of Education, one position with a two-year term:
 - a. Erica Kazlo
 - b. No designated petition was filed for this position. Write in votes resulted in Todd Malbon.
 - c. No designated petition was filed for this position. Write in votes resulted in Ann Tesar.

The polls were closed at 8:00 PM. There were 290 voters. (278 voters at the polls and 12 absentee votes)
