

Dear Parents,

The District has received a report from the health department listing all staff and students who will be placed in quarantine for precautionary measures until November 2nd. The students and staff that have been contacted will be on full remote instruction until that time. Due to the large number of staff being placed in quarantine, all 7th graders in both cohorts and 8th grade cohort B only will be fully remote until 11/2. All other grade levels and staff will continue with school on their normal schedules starting Tuesday, October 27th. Parents who would like meals for their children who are on the quarantine list can pick up meals in the elementary loop between the hours of 11:00-12:00. If you need assistance getting meals please feel free to reach out to our Transportation Director at 518-546-3301, ext. 301. Listed below is our new schedule until November 2nd:

Monday, October 26th-full remote day for all grade levels

Tuesday, October 27th- regular schedules for grades pre-k-6

- grade 7, cohort A&B, full remote until November 2

- grade 8, cohort A, regular schedule, cohort B full remote until 11/2

- grades 9-12, regular schedules

There will be no changes to the cohort schedule for grades 7-12.

All CVTEC students will resume current schedules on Tuesday, October 27th

All full time BOCES students, no changes at this time

Saint Mary's students, no changes at this time

No after school athletics on Monday, practices and games may resume on Tuesday, JV and varsity only.

As a District, we will continue to work very hard to ensure the safety of our students while in school. Thank you for your continued support and understanding as we continue to battle this virus.
