The Annual Meeting, Budget Vote and Election of Board Members was held on Tuesday, May 17, 2022 from 1:00 PM to 8:00 PM in the Central Office Lobby.

The polls were declared open at 1:00 PM.

District Voters Voted:

1. **Proposition #1**

Resolved that the Board of Education of the Moriah Central School District, Essex County be and hereby is, authorized

To Expend the Sum of \$19,778,674.

2. **Proposition #2**

Shall the Board of Education of Moriah Central School purchase two student transportation vehicles at a cost not to exceed **\$277,900** including required furnishings and costs incidental thereto and levy a tax in the amount of **\$277,900**, to be collected in annual installments, issue bonds and notes in an amount not to exceed **\$277,900**, and levy a tax to pay the interest on said obligations when due.

The Moriah Central School District as a local agency pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), ECL Section 8-0101, et seq., and implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617, having reviewed the impact of the student transportation vehicle acquisition described herein upon the environment, determined that such project constitutes a "Type II Action" under the Regulations and, as such, is not subject to review under SEQRA.

- 3. For four candidates to fill four seats on the Board of Education, three positions each with a three-year term and one position with a one-year term:
 - a. Dana Gilbo
 - b. Anthony Harlow
 - c. Benjamin Winters
 - d. Michael J. Celotti

The polls were closed at 8:00 PM. There were 212 voters. (186 voters at the poles and 26 absentee votes).
